Brethren,

As you may know, Grand Lodge is implementing new plastic dues cards this year. The new cards will have a QR code that can be scanned with a smartphone. The code when scanned will indicate whether the cardholder is current or not current with paid dues. Over time the plastic cards will save money by eliminating the cost to produce and mail paper cards every year.

Dues statements will mailed soon. Dues are \$75.00 for non-Life Members plus the Grand Lodge assessment of \$25.00. Life members are required to pay the \$25.00 assessment. The Lodge has elected to waive the \$25.00 assessment for all 50 year members.

Brothers who are in arrears in dues more than one year will be dropped from the membership roll in December.
